
















Japanese Seed Bead shapes and sizes currently stocked

Japan produces the highest quality seed beads. They are a uniform size and tend to have a larger hole than seed beads produced in other countries. There are 3 major manufacturers of seed beads in Japan, Miyuki, Toho, and Matsuno. Between them they offer the greatest range of colour, size, shape and finish and new shapes and colours are often being released.

These diagrams are provided by the manufacturers and provide an easy view of the shape from the side and hole ends. Each shape may come in a few sizes, check each shape for details.
